Previous meeting minutes:

- Mynda has some potential contacts for ROES history information - will get back to us at a later date (no rush)
- Motioned to approve previous meeting minutes by Chelsea, seconded by Dana & Katie

Principal's Update: Jen was unable to attend

Teacher's Update: Lisa was unable to attend

Treasurer's Report *Lindsey absent, sent along the completed September budget*

- Fun Run breakdown
 - \$18,313.25 raised - 97% of funds were kept by the school
 - Portion raised goes to funding Field Day
 - Average raised per student \$86.70
 - 188 different students raised money
- Rock wall vote : 7 vote yes, unanimous amongst paid members
 - Looking to install over Christmas break, if able
 - Looking into an additional adaptive swing - checking needs & cost with the center based classes & teachers
 - This is separate from the budget for rock wall.
- 5th grade field day shirts were donated last year - hoping to get a donation for this year as well, but we will be ensuring this year's classes get them also regardless
 - Mynda has potential sponsors for this
- Roller Skating was pulled via district - \$1,000 in the budget for this will be reallocated
- Many concerns were raised over the budget, teacher's funding & staff requests & how those are broken down
 - We have increased each teacher's budget since 2022-2023 school year
 - We format things slightly different in the budget for equity, have had nothing but positive feedback from teachers/staff
 - Jen has helped cover more this year than we have had help with in previous years
 - There is no "surplus" despite our Fun Run success - we need to keep a certain amount in the bank, & this helps cover everything for the year. Will discuss if anything additional can be added depending on incoming funds the rest of the year.

New Business:

- Read & Feed Ideas:
 - Sign up prior for parents to show up next year
 - Use walkies to communicate with recess paras
 - Potential use of AVID, NHS students to help with volunteering at R&F & future events
 - Can set up reading time for kids without families in attendance
 - This may become a once a year event - potentially Fall due to Storybook Pumpkins, however spring is a quieter time period.
- Additional ideas for budget/big items:
 - Media tables - Lisa has big say in these
 - Very expensive - have already looked into these, need more suppliers to compare cost breakdowns.
- Conference meals:
 - Tuesday is being donated by Culver's, Thursday is a pasta dinner put on by donations & PTA.
